McCartney opened Roadrunner Gallery in December 2018. In addition to McCartney's artwork, the gallery also provides a variety of services. She is currently planning a collaborative original collection with pencil artist Heather Green.

"My goal as a photographer is to capture the essence of the people, land and animals in authentic ways," she says. "There are many stories to be told about this way of life and I want my images to be the ultimate storyteller."
